## **Goals and objectives of the Global Forum on Risk and Disaster Reduction:**

**Localize sustainable development projects under the UN SDGs, addressing risks and disasters in the region**

**Promote platforms for raising awareness on disasters and hazards to the population**

**Draw attention of international community to risks and disasters**

**Involvement of Civil Society Organizations in Decision-Making Processes**

**Call for joint actions by community leaders and civil society organizations to implement the Sendai Framework**

## **Key messages from Bir Duino during the plenary discussion:**

- Global disaster risks point to the importance of having a clear vision and strategies to address risks and disasters within UN countries, taking into account social, economic and environmental indicators, based on the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction, the UN Sustainable Development Goals and OSCE partnership principles.**
- It is important to pay attention to reducing the gaps between local communities living with significant risks and hazards and government decision makers at all levels of government;**
- Develop a set of measures to prevent emergencies and reduce disaster risk while building resilience to new climate and human-made hazards based on the experience of the GNDR's "View from the Frontlines" project.**





- It is necessary to analyze and create new effective institutions to promote the voices of communities from local to global, with the participation of international financial institutions, civil society organizations, regional experts, women leaders and activists from all regions of Kyrgyzstan, based on the UN Security Council Resolution 1325.
- Promote gender equality and gender equity in decision-making processes on climate change and the role of women and youth to strengthen the role of communities and local authorities in preventing risks, conflicts and disasters.



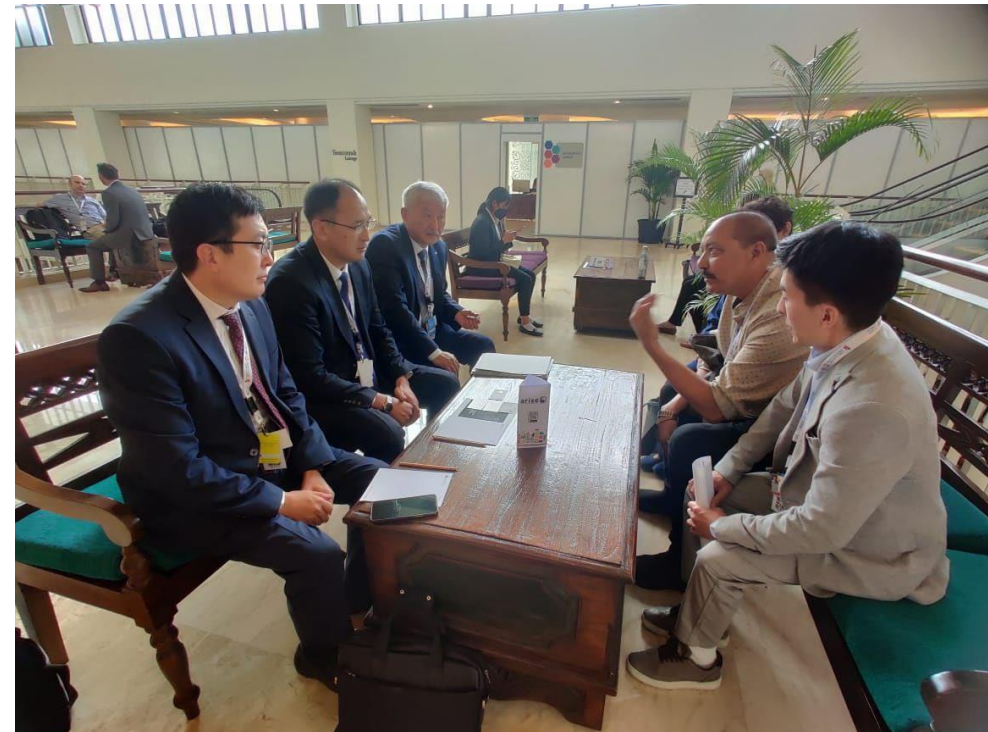
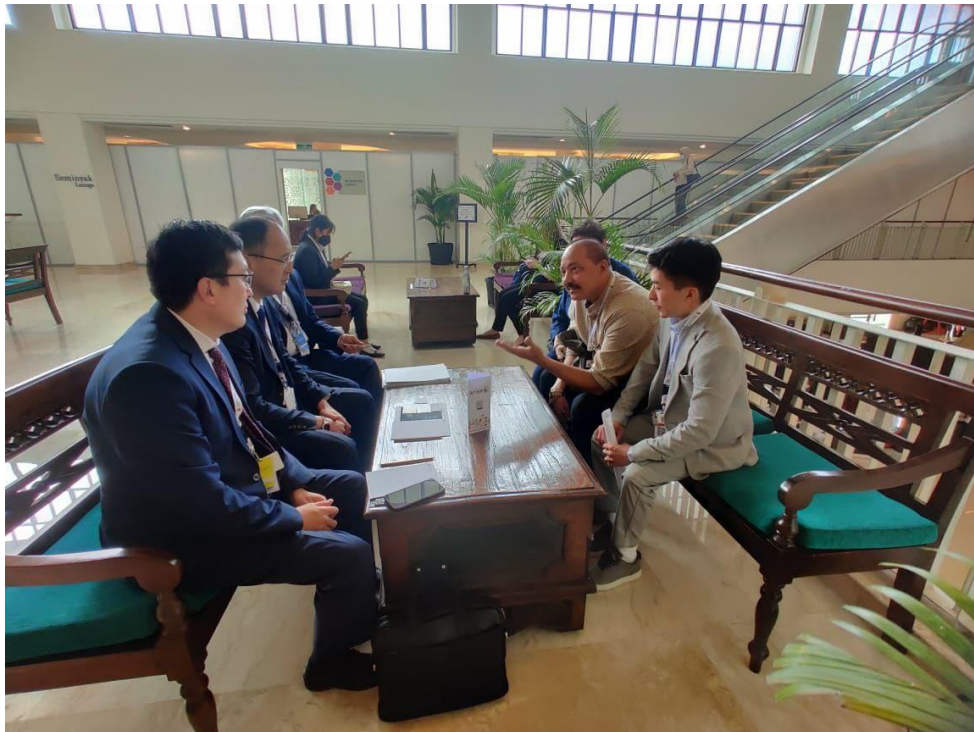
- It is important to increase the awareness and involvement of communities in the implementation of local action plans and investment projects aimed at regional development, taking into account the needs and requirements of the population.
- Develop joint measures to improve the effectiveness of measures based on specific GNDR indicators and indicators on risks and disasters: - the number of lives saved from emergencies and hazards, - the number of people affected by natural disasters, - the amount of economic losses



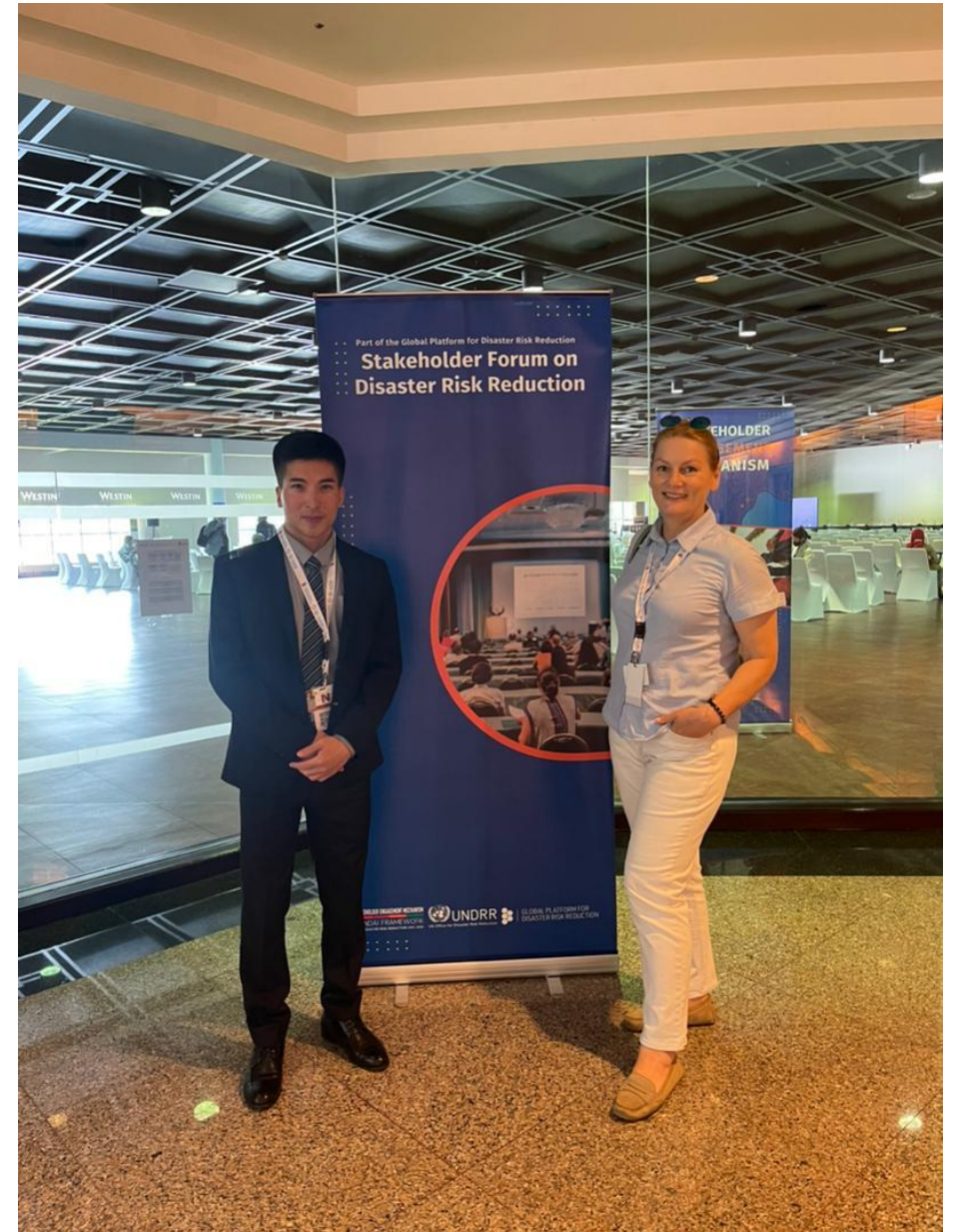
During the Global Platform 2022 Global Forum with the assistance of Bir Duino Kyrgyzstan a meeting was organized between GNDR Director Bijay Kumar and First Deputy Minister of Emergency Situations of the Kyrgyz Republic Azamat Mambetov to discuss key issues of bilateral cooperation. As a result of the discussions further joint steps in 3 main directions were developed:

1. Attraction of grant investments to the KR for uranium tailings reclamation;
2. Works on endangered glaciers recovery on the whole territory of KR;
3. Development of local communities at risk and disasters.

A GNDR delegation is scheduled to visit Bishkek in November 2022 to prepare joint action plans.



- As a result of the Global Forum 2022 in Indonesia between the Human Rights Movement "Bir Duino Kyrgyzstan" and the Association for Disaster Risk Reduction of Poland "GOTOWI.ORG" a preliminary agreement was reached on further joint outreach and educational initiatives to promote community leaders and the exchange of practical experience between Kyrgyzstan and Poland.







- A particular focus of Bir Duino during the Global Forum was to develop multi-stakeholder partnerships with leaders of organizations to increase the composition and representation of GNDR members at the UN world level, and to develop new approaches for communities to address risks and disasters.
